QUESTION ONE

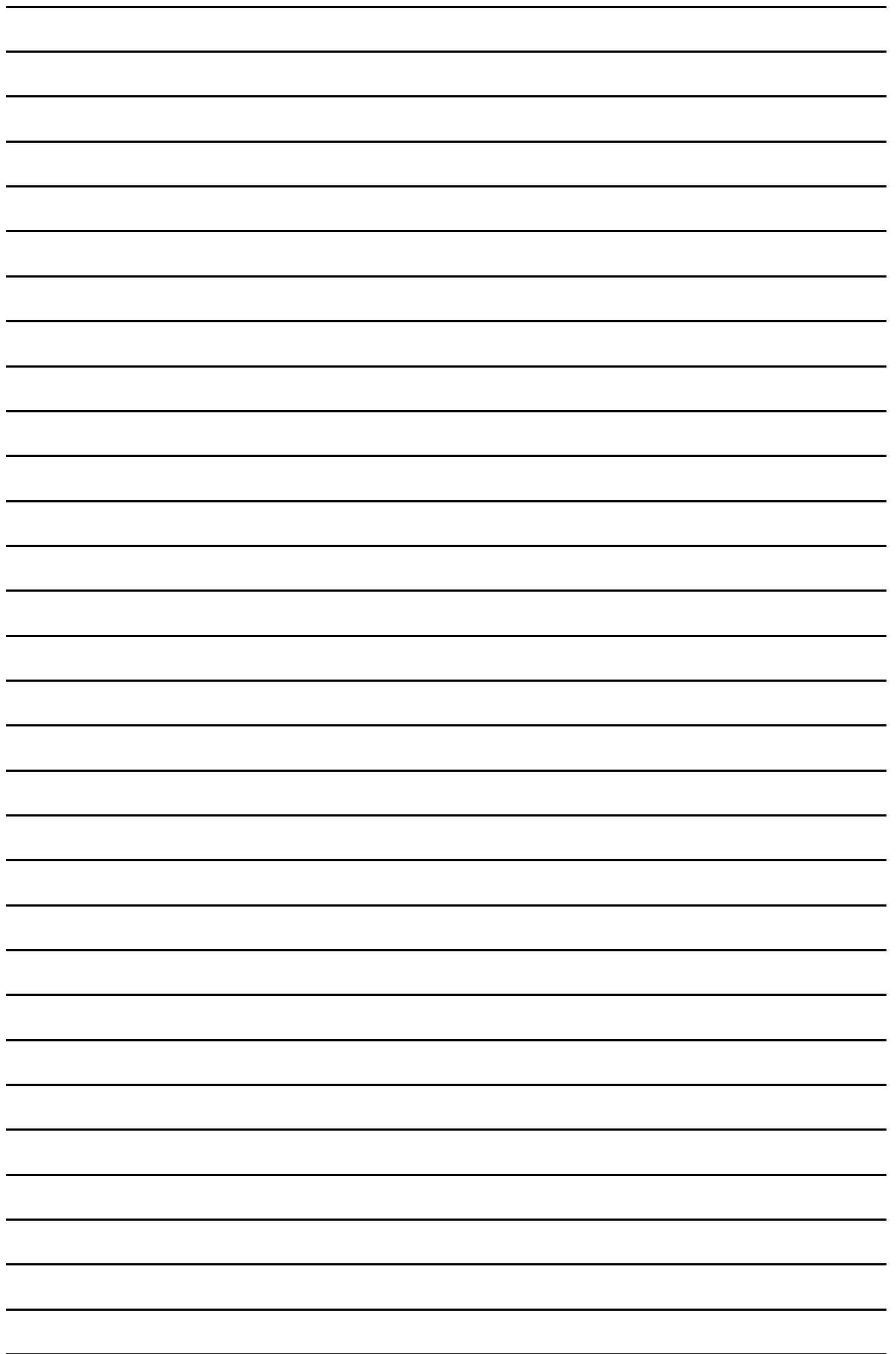
(a) Explain the purpose of the QBA Psychic Calls Register.

(a) You have conducted a one day Swiss Teams for 28 tables. What information do you send to the State Masterpoint Secretary after the event?

(b) Who else must be sent reports of the congress?

QUESTION SIX

A Club Championship event you are directing is being conducted under QBA Regulations. The qualifying round has been scored. Three 7 table sections each played 28 boards in a Mitchell movement. You have announced that first and second NS and EW from each section shall qualify for the Championship Final as well as the best third NS and the best third EW.

(a) NS Pair A and NS Pair B in one section are tied for second on 225 matchpoints. Third in the other NS fields are Pair C with 230 and Pair D with 220 matchpoints. Which pairs out of A, B, C, D qualify for the Championship Final?

(b) The first three scores in each EW field are:

QUESTION EIGHT

You are directing a 30 table one day Swiss teams event. 7 eight board matches are to be played, 4 matches before lunch, 3 matches after lunch.

You learn shortly before the starting time that Team 5 (drawn to play Team 20 in match one) isn't coming. No "house team" is available.

Explain how you overcome this problem. Boards are available for whatever course of action you take.

QUESTION NINE

(a) Early in a teams match you are called to a table because the auction had already started before it was realized that the board had been arrowswitched. What do you do?

(b) You have awarded Average Plus to Team A NS and Average Minus to Team B EW because it was found towards the end of playing the hand that East had 14 cards and West had 12 cards. At the other table the North plays a contract of 4H making 10 tricks for +620.
How do the teams score this match?

QUESTION TEN

After 2 qualifying sessions and prior to the start of 2 sessions of barometer finals a pair tells you that they want to withdraw from the event. They have squabbled constantly and have been generally disruptive.
Do you allow them to withdraw? Give your reasons.

QUESTION ELEVEN

Manually score the following two boards from a Mitchell movement. Use double match pointing. Computer scoring is not acceptable. Where a table score is missing write the score you would award according to the information given.

- (a) At Table 6 you award a split score after a misexplanation by NS is followed by a rash or gambling action by EW. NS 150; EW -800.
