

Page 7 Congress Entry Forms – delete (b) QBA approved red MP Congress (f) A statement as to the systems permitted (g) Each player must have an approved current ABF System Card. Players are responsible for ensuring the correctness of their system classification (h) Method used for dividing Plate and Consolation Sections (i) Graded Events – to be amended with at least two Grades (j) Tie Breaking Regulations (k) Yellow Systems. Add Systems allowed.

Page 31 Graded Congresses – Last Paragraph to read. The eligibility for Masterpoint cut-off will be no later than 2 clear calendar month. Example – any event held in January would have the cut off date end of October.

Page 32 Section E – remove the amount of teams allocated to Queensland for the GNOT

Page 40 Section F – under Scoring – delete WBF Continuous Scale and replace with ANC VP Principal

Page 60 Conduct of Tournament to read

To be deleted - Each player must have an approved system card (identical to partners) on the table. The only approved system card is the ABF card. Players should have their cards labelled with the appropriate coloured sticker. It is the players responsibility to ensure that their system classification is correct for the event they are playing in or penalties may be applied.

In accordance with the principle of active ethics, players must pre-alert their opponents, before the start of play, to any unusual agreements on self-alerting calls, particularly those calls which opponents may assume have a more standard meaning. The declaring side should offer a full explanation of their auction before the opening lead is made.

Membership of the Appeals Committee should be announced. (Remember that members of the QBA Appeals Committee, as far as possible, should be used.)

Expiry time for appeals, unless the standard 30 minutes after the posting of scores is to apply.

Permitted systems.

Tie-breaking procedures (the QBA regulations to apply unless otherwise specified)

If a draw is occurring, whichever draw is used (live or delayed).
