

## InterClub Teams 2017

Each QBA-affiliated Brisbane Zone club may field 4 teams, 1 only in each grade based on masterpoint rankings following the end of the September masterpoint update.

Gradings agreed to by club delegates are:

- A: Open, any masterpoint ranking;
- B: Each team member to hold less than **400** masterpoints;
- C: Each team member to hold less than **100** masterpoints;
- D: Each team member to hold less than **10** masterpoints.

Teams will be of 4 players, all of whom should be members of the nominating club (but need not be home club members).

Clubs fielding fewer than 4 teams may win any sectional prizes offered but are ineligible for the InterClub trophy.

Scoring: The scoring method will beimps converted to Victory points using the appropriate WBF continuous scale.

The overall winner will be the club with the highest aggregate score from its 4 teams.

The winning club will hold the InterClub Trophy for one year.

The awarding of prizes to the winners of each grade is at the discretion of the host club.

The event is RED masterpointed. (B5i)

QBA tournament regulations apply.

Blue, green and red systems are permitted in A grade; blue and green systems only are permitted in B, C and D grades.

Entry fee of \$90 per team was determined by the AGM and includes lunch.

For 2017, the Interclub Teams will be held on Sunday 19 November at the Brisbane Bridge Centre (BBC), Yeronga Memorial Park (Frederick St entrance) 104 Frederick Street, Annerley. Starting time is 9.30 am.
